Dear Customer:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Kaukauna Utilities (KU) has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) to adjust its electric rates.

The 2017 electric rate adjustment has been requested in order to cover costs associated with capital projects and maintaining the reliability of the electric distribution system and increases in operational and maintenance expenses.

The utility is requesting an overall increase of 1.96% or \$1,113,018. The final impact of the rate increase upon individual customers will not be definitely known until the PSC issues an order. However, under the proposed rate structure, a typical residential customer's monthly bill with an average usage of 742 kilowatt-hours (kWh) would increase from \$85.86 per month to \$89.38 per month, an increase of \$3.53 or 4.1%. KU's last electric rate increase was initiated in March 2015 and authorized in May 2016.

The PSC will review the application to make certain that in providing KU with the financial resources needed to operate the utility, your interests as a ratepayer are also considered. After reviewing the application, the PSC will conduct a public hearing at locations in Kaukauna and Madison. If the application is approved by the PSC, it is anticipated the new rates would go into effect in early 2018.
