

## Is Your Business Prepared for a Tax Audit?

Kaukauna Utilities occasionally hears from commercial customers facing tax audits. We want to remind you to stay prepared! If your business is fully or partially tax-exempt, review your invoices to ensure that the sales tax on electric service charges is accurate.

## Attention Landlords/Property Managers!

Did you know that electricity for residential dwellings is 100% tax-exempt from November to April each year? If you receive an invoice for a utility account where tenants reside, you may qualify.

To update your tax exempt status with Kaukauna Utilities:


- 1. Visit DOR Sales and Use Tax Forms (wi.gov)
